

**Training and Novice Derby
Friday, June 13, 2008**

MeadowCreek Park will offer a Training and Novice Derby on Friday, June 13, 2008. A Derby consists of each competitor riding a dressage test, and then a jumper course that consist of 6 stadium fences and 6 cross-country fences. The dressage score is added to jumping score for the final placing. The jumping score consists of: penalties from dropped rails, disobediences and time penalties.

- 1) **ENTRIES:** a) All divisions=\$35. b) Draw checks to MeadowCreek Park, Inc. c) **Refunds:** Complete refund for any reason prior to June 12th. No refunds after June 12th. d) Negative coggins required within 12 months on all horses. No exceptions.
- 2) **TENTATIVE TIME SCHEDULE:** Thurs: Park opens-noon. Derby course open 3:00 pm. Fri: Dressage begins at 1:00 pm. Training in one arena, and Novice in a second arena. From dressage, competitor will go to warm up for jumper round. Time will be allowed for tack change and warm up.
- 3) **AWARDS:** 6 ribbons in each division.
- 4) **STARTING TIMES:** Available June 12th. Times posted at www.meadowcreekpark.net. No starting times will be mailed.
- 5) **STABLING/VETERINARIAN:** \$45/stall-Thurs noon to Sunday evening. **\$20 grounds fee if not stabling.** 200 permanent stalls on grounds. Initial bedding provided. Additional shavings available from show secretary. Add **\$5.00 for electrical fan** in stall (fans not provided by organizer). Veterinarian # posted at scoreboard.
- 6) **ACCOMODATIONS:** list of motels attached. Call secretary for additional info. Bunkhouse and Guest House not available for this weekend. Camping-Electrical and water hookup \$45 for weekend.
- 7) **DIRECTIONS:** See Horse Trial information.
- 8) **DRESSAGE:** Training-2006 USEF Training Test A-Sm arena. Novice-2006 USEF Novice Test A-Sm arena.
- 9) **JUMPING COURSE.** Training- 6 stadium efforts, 6 cross-country efforts, approximately 1200 m @ 425 mpm. Novice- 6 stadium efforts, 6 cross-country efforts, approximately 1000 m @ 375 mpm.
- 10) US Eventing Assn jumping rules apply.

**Gambler's Choice
Saturday, June 14, 2008**

MeadowCreek Park will offer a Gambler's Choice on Saturday, June 14, 2008 following the Schooling Jumper Classes. A certain number of jumps are set in the arena. Each carries from 10 to 120 points according to difficulty. They can be jumped from both directions. The competitor is credited with the number of points carried by each obstacle that he (she) has jumped correctly. Each competitor has 60 seconds to jump the obstacles of his (her) choice. (Rules for Jumping) Jp 149. **One-half of entry fee is put into a pot, with winner take all!**

- 1) **ENTRIES.** A) All classes \$20/class. !/2 of entry fees put into pot for winner take all. b) Draw checks to MeadowCreek Park, Inc. c) **Refunds.** Complete refund for any reason prior to June 13th. No refunds after June 13th. d) Negative coggins required within 12 months. Required for all horses. No exceptions.
- 2) **TENTATIVE TIME SCHEDULE:** Thurs: Park opens-noon. Fri: Derby. Sat: Jumper Classes 9:00 am. Gambler's Choice 6:00 pm.
- 3) Awards. All classes – ribbons 1st through 6th place. **1st place winner receives 1/2 of entry fees for class.**

Schooling Dressage

Schooling dressage classes offered Friday afternoon and Saturday afternoon. Competitors may ride any USEF or USDF test. Please indicate on entry form the test you wish to ride. Cost \$10/class. Ride times posted on scoreboard and available from secretary.

Cross Country Schooling

Competitors who have entered the Derby, Schooling Jumper Classes, Schooling Jumper Classes or the Schooling Horse Trial may school the cross-country course at no additional charge. Competitors who have entered the Schooling Horse Trial may school the Cross-Country Course prior to the Horse Trial, but must then ride the Horse Trial "HC." No ribbons or points. Competitors who are schooling only, and not entering any event or class must pay a schooling fee of \$35 for one day, or \$50 for the weekend. Schooling fees include the use of a stall.

9) **CROSS COUNTRY:** **OP**-2800 m @ 520 mpm.**OT**-2400 m @ 420 mpm. **ON**-2000 m @ 350 mpm. **BNH/BNR**-2000 m @ 350 mpm/max fence height = 2'6". **GAG** - 1500m@300mpm/max fence height = 2'0".*Terrain:* Open pasture, woods. **All courses:** Average, for horse with some experience at these levels.

10) **OTHER INFORMATION:** Entry limit=200. Rider limit=2 horses/level. Divisions **will** be further divided if entries warrant; state birthday/experience on entry. If no experience listed, greater assumed. Prize list available from secretary. Food on grounds. Concession opens Fri noon. **Dogs must be leashed at all times.** Small children should be closely supervised. **VENDOR FEE \$25,** call secretary. **Volunteers needed for fence judges and other positions. Please sign up with show secretary.**
